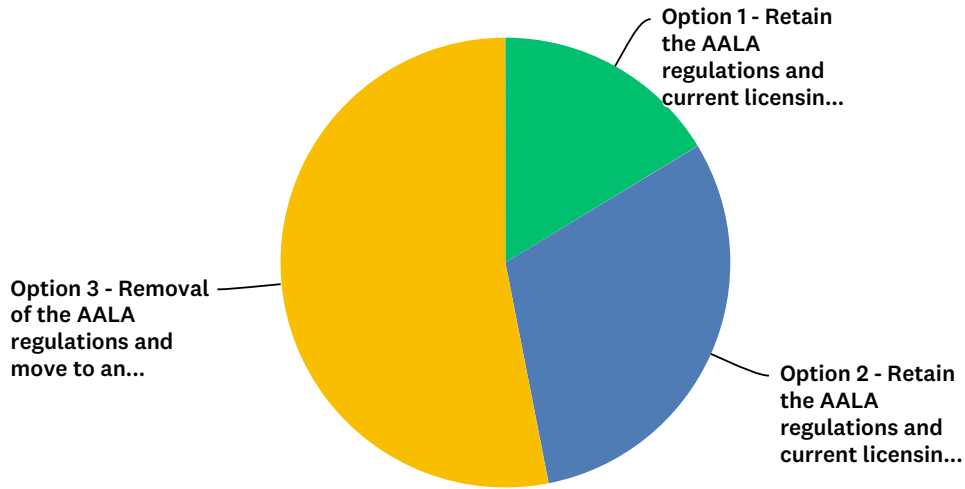


Q1 Which of the following options set out by the HSE would you chose:

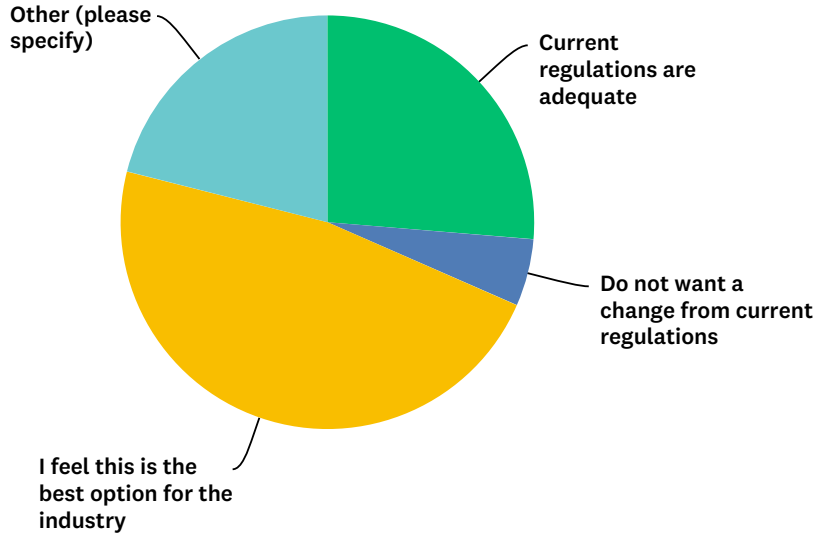

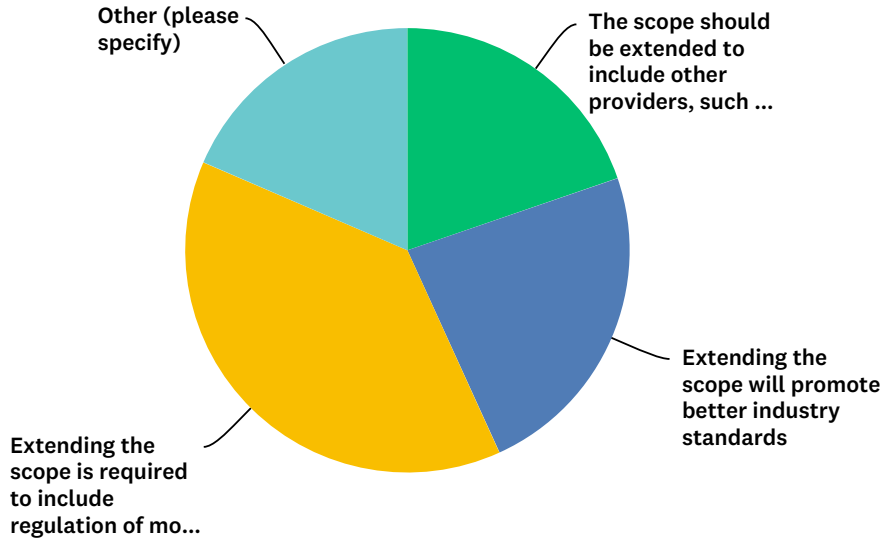

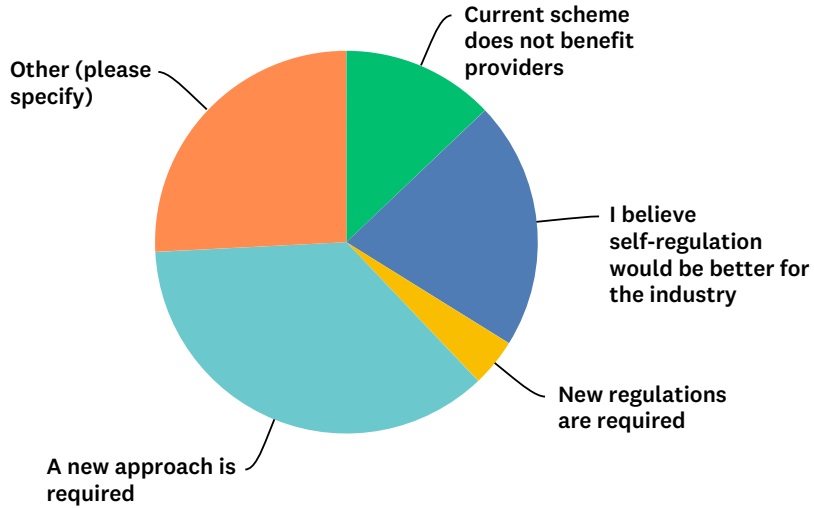
